# Greece

**Cyclades** – leave from Athens or Lavrion and visit classic Greek Islands such as Mykonos, Syros and Santorini, with their white washed houses, brilliant blue sea and vibrant night life. The Cyclades are generally for the more experienced sailor with the prevailing “Meltemi” wind which blows from the north, gusting between force 5-7 in July and August.

**Saronic Gulf and Peloponnese** – leaving from Athens this area offers more sheltered cruising grounds with mild winds averaging force 3-5, usually from the north. Visit unspoilt anchorages and peaceful fishing villages of islands like Hydra, Spetses and Poros, or cruise the eastern side of the Peloponnese.

**Dodecanese** – to explore this area you can start from Kos or Rhodes. Situated off the Turkish coast the Dodecanese islands take their name from the Greek word “twelve”, due to the 12 major and 120 minor islands situated there. The prevailing wind, like the Cyclades, is the “Meltemi” which in high season can blow force 4-6 mainly from the north-west.

**Ionian Sea** – with bases on both Lefkas and Corfu the light winds and short distances between islands make this the perfect cruising ground for the less experienced or those with young families. With golden beaches and turquoise waters enjoy this stunning location including islands such as Paxos, Antipaxos, Ithaca and Kefalonia.

**Sporades and Gulf of Volos** – visit this beautiful archipelago which includes Skiathos, for some exhilarating sailing alongside secluded anchorages, golden beaches and traditional Greek villages. Winds are generally consistent from midday to early evening averaging force 4-5, although stronger gusts can occur during July and August when the “Meltemi” blows down from the north.

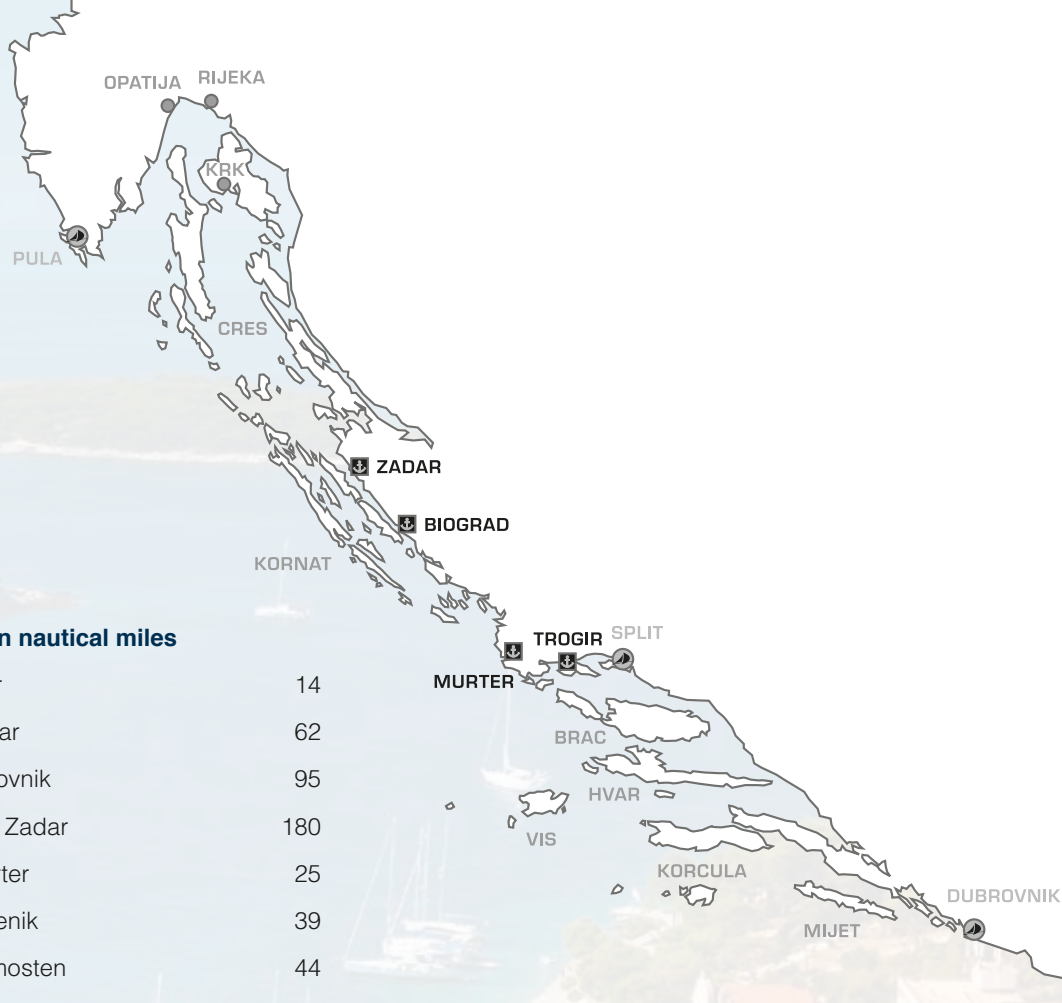

Split or Trogir and the surrounding area provides the ideal starting point to discover the southern islands such as Hvar, Korcula and Vis.

Alternatively, start your charter from the medieval town of Dubrovnik with its beautiful architecture and historic culture. The Dubrovnik Riviera offers picturesque islands surrounded by postcard blue waters.

With blue skies and a consistently warm climate during the summer months Croatia is the perfect cruising destination. Winds are generally reliable and from the north-westerly direction ranging from force 2-5.

This cruising area offers sheltered sailing with hundreds of protected anchorages, ideal for swimming in clear blue waters.

Perfect sailing conditions from May to October with a steady north-westerly wind blowing between force 2-5.

**Turkey** is a great late season destination due to its reliable weather conditions and warm seas.

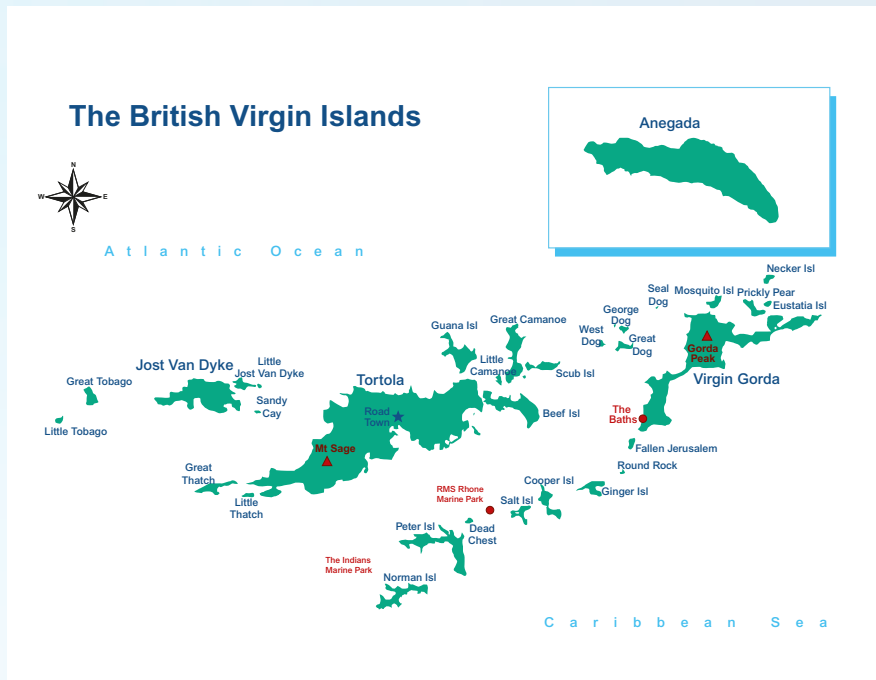

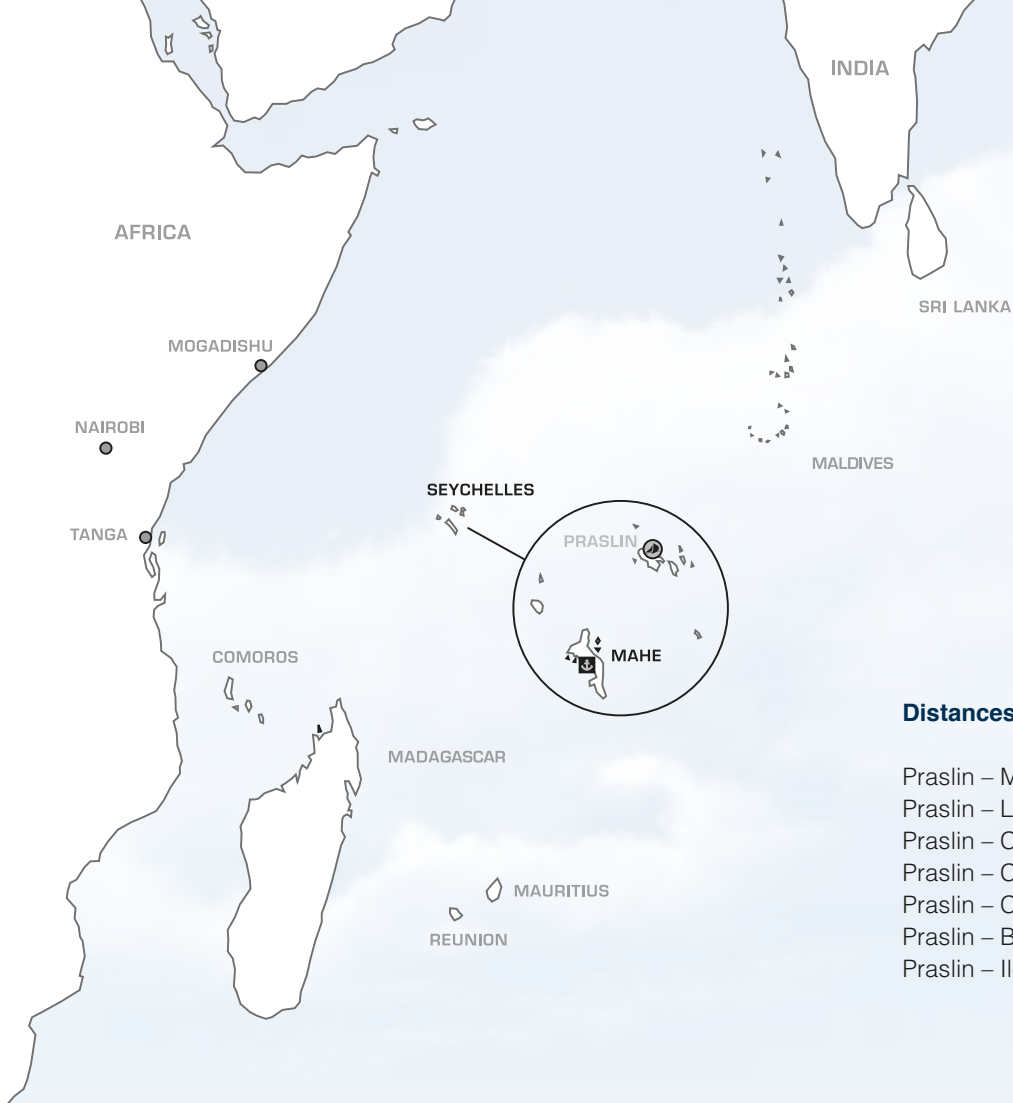

From October to March the north-westerly trade winds blow with a force of 3-4. Stronger south-easterly trade winds blow between May and September with an average of force 3-5.

**Thailand** – Phuket is Thailand's largest island and the start of your charter holiday. With hundreds of islands to see, countless beaches dotted with palm trees,

shimmering seas and charming villages, a trip to Thailand won't disappoint. October to May experiences dry and sunny weather with a north-easterly wind, force 2-5. June to October is humid and rainy with a south-west wind, force 2-7.

**Malaysia** – located in the south-east of Asia just north of the Equator, explore remote beaches, rainforests and jungles with animals found nowhere else in the world. A constant high temperature averaging between 26-29°C degrees makes this one of the more exotic destinations. The average year round wind is force 2-5 from the south-westerly or north-easterly direction.
